5 B O T

Fully charge battery for the first time before starting the therapy.

Charging time can be up to 4 hours.

Recharge battery throughout the length of the therapy. The expected battery time generally exceeds 10 hours.



- Obtain and open a new Invia Motion canister/tubing set package. CAUTION
- Make sure the correct canister is used: Ref 087.4016.
- Contact your healthcare professional if the correct canister is not available
- 8 Remove the canister/tubing set from the packaging and attach it to Invia Motion NPWT pump.









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- 10 Open the clamp on the dressing tubing. Also make sure the clamp on the pump is open.
- ⇉ Switch the Invia Motion NPWT pump on by pressing the 🕑 button. Slide the Invia Motion NPWT pump into the carrying case.
- 12 Ask your clinician how to properly dispose of a used canister/tubing set
